

If this is not received, BSJ will consider the authorization to be valid and continue to send monthly invoices.

Upon execution of the lobby authorization letter, Bolton St. Johns will charge an annual fee of \$1,000. This fee will include NYS and NYC filing fees as well as administrative fee.

Other services in addition to lobbying will not be provided by the Lobbyist.


