**Re: Written Authorization for Employed Lobbyists 2021-2022**

To whom it may concern,

Syracuse University will be lobbying on its own behalf. The individuals listed on the 2021-2022 Statement of Registration, including those that may be added through amendments from time-to-time, are University employees who are authorized to lobby on behalf of the University. Although each employee provides services to the University other than lobbying services, the anticipated compensation paid to them specifically for lobbying services for 2021-2022 will likely exceed the \$5,000 threshold, and in the University's estimate based on lobbying activities in 2020, may amount to approximately \$20,000 total per year.
