Re: Written Authorization for Employed Lobbyists 2025-2026

To Whom it May Concern,

Syracuse University will be lobbying on its own behalf. All individuals listed on the 2025-2026 Statement of Registration, including those that may be added through amendments from time-to-time, are University employees who are authorized to lobby on behalf of the University. Syracuse University and these authorized employees will be lobbying about issues related to higher education and the city and region in which Syracuse University operates. The University anticipates its lobbying contacts will involve legislators, council persons, their staffers, county and local government officials.

Although each employee provides services to the University other than lobbying services, the anticipated compensation paid to them specifically for lobbying services for 2025-2026 may exceed the \$5,000 threshold.
